

Equipment

Player Equipment

No HCMHA players will be allowed on the ice without adequate protective equipment. Player equipment consists of: CSA certified helmet with cage, gloves, elbow pads, hockey pants, chest protector, shin pads, hockey skates, athletic supporters, neck protector and hockey stick. This is to be monitored by each team's coaching staff and players will not be permitted to be on the ice if they are missing equipment or if equipment shows signs of damage or disrepair. It is each player's responsibility to supply their own equipment and HCMHA is not responsible for lost or damaged equipment.

Goaltending Equipment

It is the policy of HCMHA to provide necessary goaltending equipment for all teams in Initiation, Novice and Atom (Goalie equipment supplied will consist of pads, blocker, catcher, chest protector and neck guard. Skates, helmet, pants and athletic support are the responsibility of the individual player.) HCMHA will provide goalie sticks for Initiation and Novice teams. Sticks for Atom and above will be the responsibility of the individual player. Occasionally, HCMHA may have equipment for other age divisions but there is no guarantee that these will be available. Borrowed goaltending equipment is the property of HCMHA and must be returned to the Equipment Manager at the end of the season.

First Aid Kits

HCMHA will provide all teams with appropriate first aid kits. Kit contents may vary depending on level of play (i.e. Initiation to Midget). First Aid kits are the responsibility of the borrowing team. All kits must be returned to the Equipment Manager at the end of each season. Kits will be restocked prior to reissue.

Pucks and Coaching Equipment

HCMHA will provide pucks, "initiation" pucks, pylons, "tutor shooters" and whiteboards to coaching staff at the start of each season. These items will be kept in the coaching locker at the Oilfields arena and all coaches who access this locker are responsible for ensuring the return of these items at the end of every practice. Locker combination will be made available to coaching staff at the beginning of the season.

Water Bottles

Water bottles are the responsibility of individual players.

Mouthguards

Mouth guards are the responsibility of the individual player and are NOT mandatory for all players in the HCMHA.
