



Registration and Fees

REGISTRATION

No player may participate in any Association activities unless he/she is properly registered with the Association. A player is registered when:

- A completed registration form and any other forms or documents deemed necessary such as the medical form, Respect in Sport Certificate and a birth certificate are filed with the Registrar of the Association and registration has been paid.
- First time and new to the area players must provide an original Birth Certificate, proof of residency, school registration and completed Parent Declaration form for the Registrar to verify where applicable as per Hockey Alberta regulations.

Association's registration deadline will be established and published annually by the HCMHA Board of Directors. The registration deadline will be determined after the AGM. All players are required to be registered by the deadline.

The ONLY exception to this deadline will be if a person moves to the High Country area from another community who desires to play hockey, providing there is room within the division they are registering in. Any exceptions must be requested in writing to the HCMHA Board of Directors.

All Players trying out for an Elite team must first register with their home association as per Hockey Alberta regulations.

HCMHA reserves the right to refuse registration of a player(s). If a player, parent/guardian or family member has caused problems within the HCMHA, a release will be given to you and your family to play with another association.

FEES

Registration fees shall cover all HCMHA assigned practice ice, assigned game ice or allotted extra ice costs including referee expenses, insurance, league fees, provincial play down fees, provincial ice as needed and other budgeted operating expenses. Individual teams are responsible for costs incurred for ice outside of HCMHA assigned times, referee expense outside of HCMHA assigned or allocated game time, tournament fees, travel expenses and other individual team expenses.

Option 1: Full payment at time of registration

Option 2: 50% payment at time of registration and 50% paid on or by August 31

Any exceptions will be reviewed by the HCMHA Board of Directors.

Registration fees will be set annually by the HCMHA Board of Directors.

All NSF cheques must be made good or registration may be rescinded. NSF cheques are subject to a \$25.00 service charge. Outstanding fees from a previous season must be paid in full prior to registration in the current year.

Fees can be fully refunded if requested in writing to the HCMHA Board of Directors by the member (if over 18) or a parent/guardian of the member prior to the start of league play. Partial refunds shall be 50% of the fee up to December 15 however there shall be no refunds after December 15.
