



Team Parent Meetings

Team parent meetings are extremely important to the successful operation of a team. The initial parent-coach meeting at the start of the season will determine parent volunteer roles for the upcoming season as well as coaches will take this time to explain their expectations and coaching philosophy. Throughout the season, many of the team decisions will be made during these meetings and every parents input is important. Parents are expected to attend all scheduled team meetings. Coaches (or meeting organizers) are expected to give parents ample notice of a scheduled meeting. A 50% majority of parents in attendance at a scheduled team meeting will rule any decisions. Meeting frequency will be determined by each team individually.
