



Player Suspension (Section 11 Maltreatment) Policy

Any player that receives penalties or incident report (no game suspension) under Section 11 Maltreatment, will be up for review and can be suspended for a minimum of 2 practices, as it is considered a violation of HCMHA Player Code of Conduct.

Any player that receives a game(s) suspension under Section 11 Maltreatment, will be suspended from practice as per the following scenarios, as it is considered a violation of HCMHA Player Code of Conduct.

1. Game suspensions of 1 to 3 games, will be suspended for 2 practices.
2. Game suspensions of 4 to 7 games, will be suspended for 4 practices.
3. Game suspensions of 8 to 10 games, will be suspended for 6 practices.
4. Game suspensions of 11+ games, will be suspended for a minimum of 6 practices and subject to review if further practice suspensions are required.
5. Game suspensions of INDEFINITE games, will be suspended until ruling is made and then subject to review if further practice suspensions are required.

Any coach that receives a game(s) suspension under Section 11 Maltreatment, will follow the Player Suspension format (above) and will be reviewed if they are to be allowed to continue as a Coach for future seasons, as it is considered a violation of HCMHA Parent/Coach Code of Conduct.

Repeated incidents of this matter, can result in expulsion from HCMHA for the remainder of the season. If a player is expelled, NO registration fee will be refunded.
