

## Coach Code of Conduct High Country Minor Hockey Association

I,	, agree to this Coaches Code of Conduct
operating	under the guidelines of the High Country Minor Hockey Association (HCMHA) for
the	season understand and fully agree to the following conditions:

## I. Responsibilities to the Players and Parents

- 1. I am committed to attending the majority (75%) of the team's activities including: games, practices and extra-curricular activities. In the event that I cannot, I will clearly communicate this with the team and provide alternate arrangements in my absence.
- 2. I agree to adhere to the HCMHA 24 hour rule for dealing with conflicts/communication. See HCMHA Policy and Procedures for more detailed explanation/break down.
- 3. I will have open honest communication with the players and their parents/guardian.
- 4. I will be available upon request to discuss any aspect of the team, team activities, practices, games etc with parents and players at a time that suits all parties.
- 5. I will be fair, helpful and encouraging to all players.
- 6. I will be respectful to all volunteers, parents, players and officials at all times.
- 7. I will provide equal instruction, support and fair playing time to all players on my team regardless of skill level.
- 8. I will not punish or threaten to punish players for mistakes made on the ice.
- 9. I will not punish or threaten to punish players for being "too good" or scoring "too much".
- 10. I will not encourage any behaviours or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.
- 11. I will not, under any circumstances provide, promote, or condone the use of drugs (legal or illegal), performance-enhancing substances and/or stimulants of any kind, in the case of minors, alcohol, tobacco, vaping or other legalized drugs.
- 12. I will enforce the philosophy with the players that doing one's best and working their hardest is more important than winning.
- 13. I will do my best to set a good example for the players.



- 14. I will never ridicule or yell at a child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 15. I will never ridicule, belittle or insult a player, coach, official or volunteer for any reason.

## II. Responsibilities to HCMHA

- 1. I will thoroughly acquaint myself with and demonstrate a working knowledge of the policies/procedures, by-laws, rules and regulations of HCMHA, Central Alberta Hockey League (CAHL) and Hockey Alberta (HA).
- 2. I agree to understand, follow, abide and respect all of the rulings, by-laws, policies/procedures, rules and regulations of HCMHA, its Executive and appointed committees as well as CAHL and HA.

## III. Responsibilities - Other

- 1. Coaches have the responsibility to conduct themselves and to also assist their players in conducting themselves properly and respectfully when in public as representatives of their team and of HCMHA.
- 2. It is unacceptable for a coach to have any verbal altercation with an official, opposing coach or bench before, during or after a game.
- 3. Officials must have the support of coaches, players and spectators. I agree to refrain from criticizing officials in the presence of players or spectators.
